- Try an "overachiever" circle time Monday Friday
- Have students post activities on Class DOJO
- Have students brainstorm ideas of what a virtual graduation might look like.
- Assign students put together a project based on age group they pick, find activity on line, describe how to make/do/play the activity and how it is beneficial to that age group.
- Have students do a lesson plan based on a famous artist
- Look for virtual field trips for students to explore and report back
- Try Better Kid Care podcasts through Penn State
- Consider joining the Family and Consumer Science Teachers Facebook page for lots of great resources.
- To motivate seniors with a less work intensive less plan, have them read to a group of preschoolers and videotape session.
- Have students create a book on Book Creator and share with preschool families.
