- Ask companies who were going to participate in career fairs to take videos of their companies and send them to you and you can post them for your students to view
- Students still out on COOP poses a problem Joanne Custer sent parents a video explaining that when school is no longer in session, the relationship is totally between the student and the employer
- These students have a grading issue: will there be a 'grade in the book' for COOP/Diversified Occupations or will they be moved back into their program?
- Many financial institutions have online budgeting/financial materials that can be used with students
- COOP/Diversified Occupations faculty might want to 'push into' other program classes to offer supplemental content for other CTE instructors (facilitate reflective journals in the world of work, etc.)
- Joanne Custer will share a recruitment video that she developed for student considering COOP
- Virtual site visits with employers for students to view
- Require that your COOP students practice formal letter writing skills by sending their COOP employers a thank you
